

Classical Ballet and Neoclassical Dance

Rules and Regulations

Solo with soft shoes – Ages (Classical and Neoclassical):

- 1) Pre Junior 9 -11
- 2) Juniors 12 – 14
- 3) Seniors 15 -18

Solo with point shoes - Ages (Classical and Neoclassical):

- 1) Juniors 13 – 15
- 2) Seniors 16 – 18

Groups only for Neoclassical Dance:

- 1) Small group (2-5 participants)
Ages:
Juniors 11-14
Seniors 15-18
- 2) Mega group (6-15 participants)
Ages:
Juniors 11-14
Seniors 15 – 18

Duration:

- 1) Solo up to 120 seconds (2 minutes)
- 2) Small group up to 150 seconds (2 ½ minutes)
- 3) Mega group up to 180 seconds (3 minutes)
- 4) The music should be uploaded to the registration system along with the registration of the participants

Outfit for girls – CLASSICAL BALLET:

- 1) Costume and hairstyle should be match the choreography they will be performing.
- 2) Soft shoes or point shoes are only allowed depending the category.

Outfit for girls – NEOCLASSICAL DANCE:

- 1) The design of the costume should be based on the style of the choreography.
- 2) The breast should be covered.
- 3) Dancers may perform barefoot, in soft shoes or point shoes.

Outfit for boys – CLASSICAL BALLET:

- 1) Costume suitable for the choreography.
- 2) Soft shoes are only allowed.

Outfit for girls – NEOCLASSICAL DANCE:

- 1) The design of the costume should be based on the style of the choreography.
- 2) Dancers may perform barefoot or in soft shoes.

Outfit for boys – NEOCLASSICAL BALLET:

- 3) Costume suitable for the choreography.
- 4) Soft shoes or barefoot are only allowed
